### *Outside Seating*

You are more than welcome to sit outside in nice weather. Please obtain a numbered spoon from the till for food orders. No food will be delivered to the trampoline area so ensure that you are seated in the areas immediately outside of the café. Also if you have children who are using the facilities in the walled garden day pass wristbands must be obtained from the ticket office/farm shop. Wristbands are checked regularly.

### *Toilets*

Male/female toilets along with disabled toilets and baby changing facilities can be found to the rear of the café and opposite the café next to the Manor House.

### *Hand Washing*

As we are a busy farm with many animals and for your own safety we strongly advise that all guests wash their hands thoroughly using our washing facilities in the toilets before eating and after interaction with the animals. This prevents the spread of disease. We also have numerous hand sanitizer points within the park for guests to use.

### *Lost children/First Aid*

Please notify the café supervisor if you have lost a member or your party of if you have a first aid incident. We have a number of trained first aiders on site who will be available to help.
